Think! Suggest New Ideas

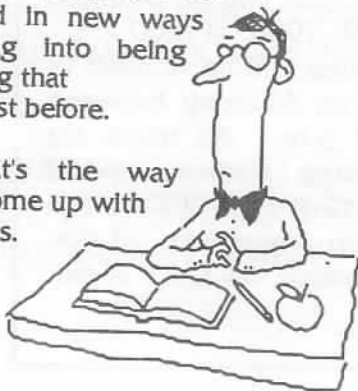
If you ask someone, "What's half of eight?" and heard "Zero," your first reaction would be, "That's nonsense."
