




Employee Response To Division Meetings

It was good to meet with our new division."




Wilma Fonoimoana



Special Projects wants to remind all employees with children age 3 - 12 years to keep April 18th open for the Center's Fourth Annual Easter Egg Hunt.


Entrance will be by ticket only, which may be picked up at Special Projects from Monday, April 13th - Friday, April 17. More information will be forthcoming.
